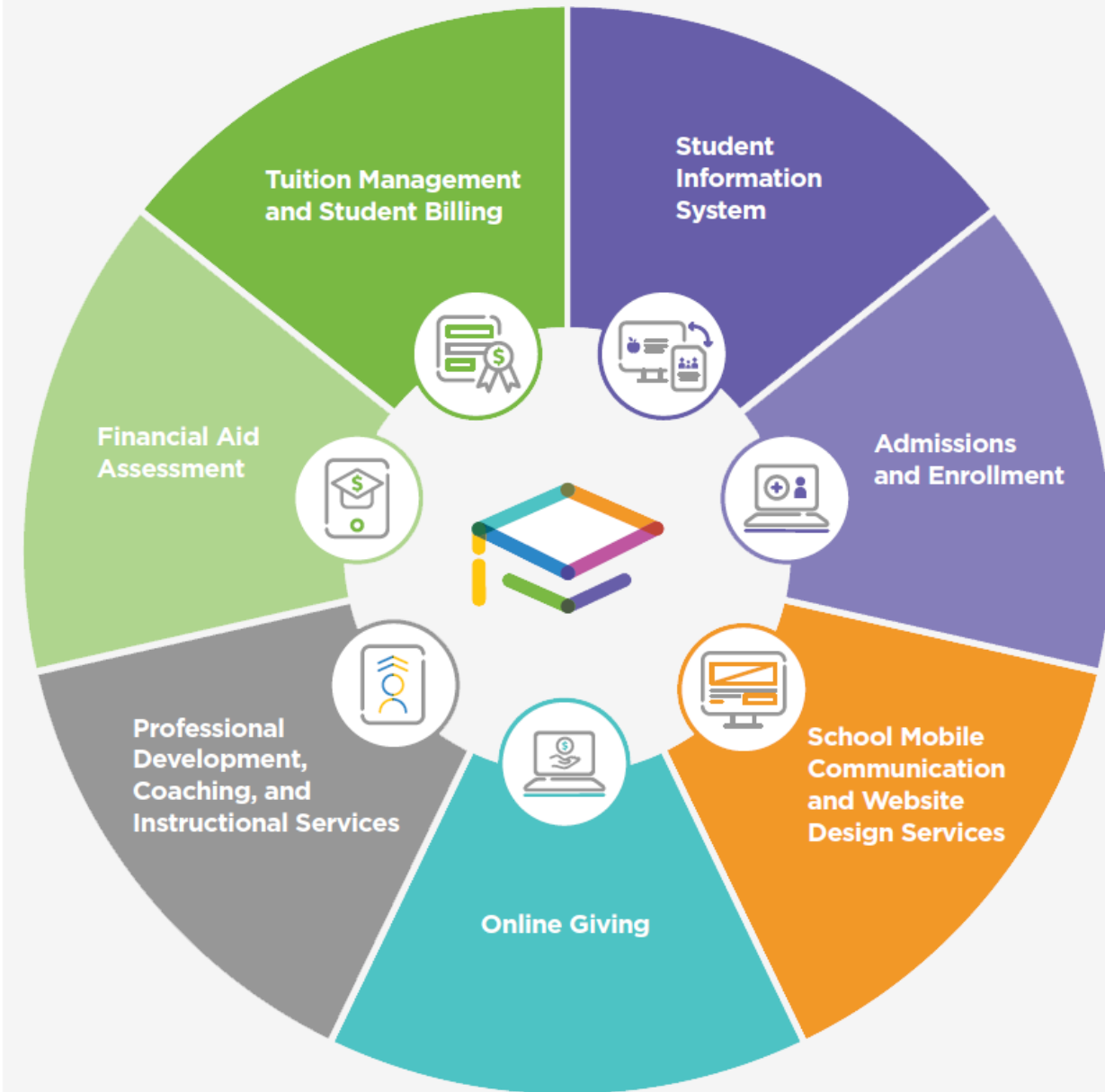

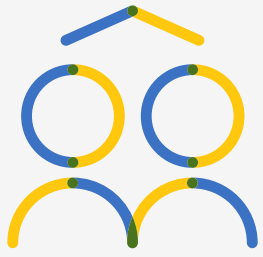

Professional Development

A 2009 report from the National Staff Development Council noted that, while 90 percent of teachers said that they participated in professional development trainings, most of them also said it was useless.

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A study that included analysis of 1,300 pieces of research found that PD programs of 14 hours or less did not affect student achievement at all – in fact, they failed to even change teachers' practices
